The Right Reverend Carol J. Gallagher

The Right Reverend Carol J. Gallagher is the first American Indian (Cherokee) female bishop in the Episcopal Church and the first indigenous female bishop in the world-wide Anglican Communion. She received her M. Div. from Episcopal Divinity School, Th.M. from Princeton Theological Seminary, and Ph.D. in Urban Affairs and Public Policy from the University of Delaware.

After successful parish and chaplaincy experiences in Delaware, Pennsylvania, and Maryland, Carol Gallagher was elected Bishop Suffragan in the diocese of Southern Virginia in October 2001 and was ordained and consecrated bishop in April 2002. She is a gifted preacher, story teller, pastor and administrator.
